USA SOUTHERN TERRITORY GULF COAST HURRICANE RELIEF Released October 11, 2005:

The Salvation Army responded immediately following Hurricanes Katrina and Rita serving the immediate needs of survivors by providing shelter, food, water, ice, cleaning supplies, and hygiene products. Over 600,000 people have been served in at least 30 states. The following information represents the Southern Territory's fifteen states and the District of Columbia.

- The Salvation Army has served 3,005,455 hot meals, 5,080,025 sandwiches, snacks & drinks.
- The Salvation Army has 150 Mobile Feeding Units (Canteens), 11 Field Kitchens, capable of producing 20,000 hot meals per day (each), (Incl. 8 Southern Baptist Kitchens.) in the many areas affected.
- The Salvation Army has distributed 110,690 Cleaning Kits. (Broom, bucket, mop & detergent) and 96,259 Food Boxes (groceries.)
- The Salvation Army has ministered through Pastoral Care to 192,414 individuals.
- The Salvation Army has registered and begun helping with 208,362 Social Services Cases.
- The Salvation Army Team Emergency Radio Network (SATERN) has received over 60,528 inquiries and has found 17, 052 survivors.
- Salvation Army officers, employees and volunteers have served a total of 561,942 hours.
- The Salvation Army has assisted a total of 735,100 individuals.
